
## THE BLAVATSKY YEARS (1887-1891)




With the intention and aim of preserving historical writings and rendering them available in a modern format for the benefit of research or study, the editors have taken on the mammoth task of compiling all of the material published in *Lucifer* magazine. This was a magazine founded in September 1887 by Helena Petrovna Blavatsky (1831–1891) and Mabel Collins (1851–1927), with the aim of publishing material focusing on Theosophy, occultism, the Eastern and Western religious traditions and more.

This compilation is published as *The Lucifer Collection* divided in two parts. Part I, entitled *The Blavatsky Years* contains all material from September 1887 to August 1891. Part II, entitled *The Post Blavatsky Years* will contain the remaining issues until and including August 1897, at which point the name of the magazine was changed to *The Theosophical Review*. The material is published in numbered volumes under selected topics.

## BLAVATSKY'S COMPANION TO PISTIS SOPHIA

The present volume is entitled *Blavatsky's Companion to Pistis Sophia* because Blavatsky published and commented, in the pages of *Lucifer* magazine, selections of the *Pistis Sophia* translated and annotated by G.R.S. Mead.

The publication project was first announced, in the pages of *Lucifer*, in the following manner: "We shall also...insert the first of some 'Selections from the Gnostic Gospel, the Pistis Sophia,' translated by G. R. S. Mead, and annotated by H.P.B." After that, a second note stated that "The promised 'Selections from the Gnostic Gospel, the Pistis Sophia,' translated by G.R.S. Mead, and annotated by H.P.B., will be commenced in our next number." Fourteen instalments of the material were published *seriatum*. However, the first instalment featured the following note "Translated and annotated by G. R. S. Mead, and annotated Pistis Sophia. Unfortunately, the translation was interrupted and only two books of the Pistis Sophia were published in *Lucifer*.

Even though this volume does not contain the complete Pistis Sophia, it still offers extremely valuable insight into the text due to the important and unique contribution that Helena Petrovna Blavatsky provided with her commentary. Her in-depth knowledge of the material she presented in her great works, in concordance with her detailed commentary to Pistis Sophia, creates a true guide towards a deeper awareness and understanding of this Gnostic Gem.

*What's in a Book* is a compilation of all book reviews published in *Lucifer* magazine while Blavatsky was the editor. The reviews featured all types of literature genres, from fiction to non-fiction, from thrillers to romance, from poetry to philosophy, from science to occultism and Theosophy, to name a few.

Blavatsky was a great admirer of fiction and considered it an important tool to promote Theosophical, occult and mystical ideas. She deemed literature as the heart and pulse of people replete with leading lights and signposts throughout the realm of the occult: "Literature—once wrote a critic—is the confession of social life, reflecting all its sins and all its acts of baseness as of heroism. Books do not represent one man, but they are the mirror of a host of men." Fictional works, in her worldview, were not mere fancies of imagination, but "true presentiments of what lies in the bosom of the future, and much of which is already born."





# WHAT'S THE BUZZ?

"What's the Buzz" is a compilation of all the reports of activities of The Theosophical Society from around the world, published in *Lucifer* magazine during the years Blavatsky was the Editor. It also contains three appendices: the first one, features obituaries published in the magazine, such as the one of Anna Kingsford and Subba Row, to name a few; the second appendix, presents notes on the Theosophical work in India and the third one Joma Sipe explanation of the frontispiece he created for the Lucifer Collection. From September of 1887 until August of 1891, it is possible to see how the Theosophical Society developed and expanded at a very fast pace. For instance, in September of 1887, there are only five entries on Theosophical work, while in August of 1891 there are 18 entries.

The work and dissolution of Lodges across the world was also highlighted in *Lucifer*. For instance, the staff of the French branch named "L'ISIS" was dismissed. There are also controversies related to The Gnostic Theosophical Society of Washington, as apparently, its founder Dr Elliot Coues declared himself "the perpetual President of the Esoteric Theosophical Society of America." Blavatsky reacted negatively to the announcement as you will read, as she had already founded the Esoteric School. Much more could be said, but it will be up to you to discover what was going on, who was doing what, where and when, and how Theosophical works around the world come together recorded and highlighted in the pages of *Lucifer* magazine.

## CHRISTIANITY

This volume of *The Lucifer Collection* entitled 'Christianity' contains nearly fifty titles, between articles and correspondence, published in *Lucifer* magazine while Helena Petrovna Blavatsky was the editor. Her approach as editor of *Lucifer* was to publish widely differing views, offering opposing sides the word on any topic and Christianity was a big one. Her profound knowledge of the ancient-wisdom tradition and many religious texts often led to her writing editorial notes correcting statements and mistakes which did not always go down well with authors and could lead to heated debates in ongoing correspondence.

As always, neither HPB nor *Lucifer* disappoint in the material offered. Each reader can unveil the inner teachings and decide what to keep or reject. Enjoy this volume on Christianity with HPB's words:

"Our magazine is essentially controversial, and was founded for the purpose of throwing light upon "the hidden things of darkness"—of religious superstition pre-eminently. And what superstition can be compared to that which accepts a "personal" God, or, a "personal" devil?"

## BLAVATSKY ON THE GOSPELS, MASONRY & CASPAR LAVATER

The present volume features *The Esoteric Character of the Gospels, The Roots of Ritualism in Church and Masonry,* written by Helena Petrovna Blavatsky; and *The Letters of Johann Caspar Lavater to the Empress Maria Feodorovna,* translated and annotated by Blavatsky. We have also chosen to include an appendix, for the reader's convenience, containing selected correspondence and articles that Blavatsky recommended reading to understand better her discussion on the gospels and ritualism: *The Soldier's Daughter* by Rev. T.G. Headley (?); *Are the Teachings Ascribed to Jesus Contradictory* by Gerald Massey (1828–1907); *The Signs of Time* and *Is Theosophy a Religion* by H.P. Blavatsky.



## ESOTERIC & EXOTERIC CHRIST & CHURCH

#### J.W. BRODIE INNES; EDWARD MAITLAND; S. E. G.

This volume features "The True Christ of Church," written by John William Brodie-Innes (1848–1923); "The Esoteric Christ," written by Edward Maitland (1824-1897); and "Ecclesiastical Christianity," written by S. E. G. (Susan E. Gay?).

John William Brodie-Innes was a member of The Theosophical Society and an influential member of the Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn's Amen-Ra Temple in Edinburgh. Blavatsky published his paper entitled "The True Church of Christ, Exoteric and Esoteric," was published *seriatum*, in *Lucifer* magazine. It focuses on both the material (visible), exoteric and spiritual (invisible) esoteric aspects of the church. *Esoteric Christ*, written by Edward Maitland, who was a member of the Theosophical Society, occultist and humanitarian discusses, among other things, the "Rival Christs, explaining that there, at least, are three different Christs: "the Orthodox Christ representing a belief form that is unrelated to mind; the negative or Agnostic Christ, indicated as the Christ within." In "Ecclesiastical Christianity" S.E.G. deals with the history of crimes the church committed, bringing them to public attention for the "cause of truth and reform."
